## **Auto Parts Recyclers Celebrate 25 Years of Quality!**

An APRAA Executive Committee Annual General Meeting (AGM) was held all day Friday 16 November at the Motor Trade Association of South Australia (MTA SA), with representatives from around the country. Mr. McAuliffe noted "The key issues discussed at the meeting included APRAA's Strategic Plan and the importance of the APRAA Accreditation Program, with members to be independently audited by the National Parts Code."

The AGM was followed by the APRAA 25 Year Anniversary Dinner, attended by enthusiastic auto parts recyclers from every state along with partners, sponsors and officials. The guests were welcomed by Mr. John Chapman (Executive Director MTA SA), with Mr. Peter Barrows (MTA SA Recycler Division Chairman) as the Master of Ceremonies. International guests included representatives from the Malaysian auto recyclers association (MAARA), as well as suppliers from UK and NZ. A great night was had by all with highlights being the historical display of APRAA's 25 years of activity representing the industry; major sponsors' messages from Autotex P/L and Capricorn Society; cutting of the cake; and an Ali G impersonator!
