



## WHY FREMANTLE?

Fremantle was established in 1829 as a port for the fledgling Swan River Colony and was the major city in Western Australia for much of its early history. Known by many as the host city for the 1987 America's Cup, Fremantle is rich in heritage and character.

Just a 30 minute drive from Perth's city centre and situated at the mouth of the Swan River, Freo, as it's known by locals, is home to a 500-strong fishing fleet and a vast number of yachts and pleasure craft — a multi-cultural city with a charm of its own, setting it apart from the rest of Perth.

Fremantle boasts world-famous heritage buildings and a fascinating maritime and convict history. Supporting this rich history is a strong creative streak that can be sampled in the arts, crafts and food available at the Fremantle Markets.

### 2009 Fremantle Festival

Coinciding with the dates of the 2009 Yard Tour, the 2009 Fremantle Festival showcases the community, coming together to celebrate Fremantle and the creative spirit of its people. The festival origins date back to the introduction of electric light to Fremantle in 1905. The City of Fremantle coordinates a number of free events within the festival.

In 2009 these free events will include the Festival Opening Event, Wardarnji Aboriginal Cultural Celebration, Lotterywest Street Parade & Carnival and the Bhangra Street Dance Party.
